

...preventing unemployment from falling







Cross-country variations in unemployment rates (percentages)






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
Youth unemployment continues to rise...



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

Unemployment rates by age in the EU-28, Q2 2014 (percentage)



Male youth unemployment and unrest (1991-2013)










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Inequality remains high in developing countries...


Inequality measured by Gini index (2010)


Evolution of the average Gini coefficient in G7 economies (2000-11)












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Future employment growth is mainly expected in services...


Sectoral employment growth (p.a.): 2013 vs. 2019



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
..as manufacturing no longer drives development...

Job creation in manufacturing makes growth slowdowns less likely



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
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Women face high risks of vulnerable employment...

Difference between male and female vulnerable employment rates (percentage points)



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
